# Mayor Fulop and the Recreation Department Announce Opening of Pools & Park Sprinklers Citywide as Summer Weather Arrives

City Receives \$45,000 Grant from The American Red Cross for Learn to Swim Program

JERSEY CITY – As the school year comes to an end, Mayor Steven M. Fulop and the Department of Recreation are gearing up for another busy summer with the opening of six pools and sprinklers at 14 parks throughout Jersey City for children and adults.

"During the summer months I encourage residents to cool off from the heat at one of our city pools and sprinklers, especially after taking part in one of our great recreational programs," said **Mayor Fulop**. "As we continue to expand recreational offerings for residents, we are mindful that means providing activities creating activities and events for the whole family at parks throughout the city."

The pool openings serve as a continuation of the Fulop administration's commitment to the growth and development of recreational programs within the community. Since taking office, Mayor Fulop has added 22 new recreation programs including, scuba, boxing, cricket, fitness programs, and programs for special needs athletes.

Along with open swim, this summer the Department of Recreation is offering a **Learn to Swim Program** for boys and girls ages six to 14. Dates for classes vary by pool and sessions are filled on a first come first serve basis. Proof of residency and a valid birth certificate are required to register on site.

To support the Learn to Swim Program, the City has received a \$45,000 grant from The American Red Cross through an anonymous donor to sponsor an aquatics program with the Jersey City Recreation Department. The grant will support free Red Cross Learn-to-Swim courses for 750 Jersey City children, 50 Lifeguard Training scholarships and 30 Water Safety Instructor scholarships, which will train individuals to be able to instruct Red Cross Learn-to-Swim courses at the Jersey City Recreation Center.

"The Red Cross recognizes the importance of water safety," said **Mathieu Nelessen**, **regional CEO**, **American Red Cross North Jersey Region**. "Whether you are at a pool or one of New Jersey's many beaches and lakes, it is important that children have the knowledge and skills they need to be safe in and around the water. We are happy that this grant will enable Jersey City children to receive potentially lifesaving water safety and swim instruction."
