PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Jersey City is prepared to accept applications from organizations interested in receiving Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) certifications and recertifications. Interested organizations must meet the following requirements:

1. Have a governing board consisting of not less than one-third low-income persons and not more than one-third public officials.
2. Have a 501(c)(3) or (c)(4) ruling from the IRS.
3. Have demonstrated a capacity for carrying out activities assisted with HOME funds.
4. Have a history of serving the community in which the HOME assisted housing is to be located (minimum of one year).
5. Have among your purposes the provision of decent housing that is affordable to low and moderate income persons as evidenced by your charter, articles of incorporation, resolution or bylaws.

All interested organizations wishing to apply for a CHDO certification / recertification and to be considered for CHDO operating funds may obtain applications effective November 11, 2011 from the following location:
