



REMARKS.
 The battle of Gettysburg was fought on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd of July, 1863. The Union forces were driven back through the town of Gettysburg, Pa., captured, then repositioned and by the next day were in the attack.
 The battle was conducted in three days at Gettysburg, Pa. The Union army of 120,000 men defeated the Confederate army of 75,000 men. The battle was a turning point in the war, as it marked the end of General Robert E. Lee's invasion of the North. The Union forces were able to recapture the town of Gettysburg and the surrounding area, and the Confederate army was forced to retreat back to Virginia.
