HURRICANE SANDY RELIEF AID

Jersey City residents and businesses that were severely affected by Hurricane Sandy can start applying for federal assistance made available as part of a disaster declaration signed by President Barack Obama.

Assistance can also include grants for temporary housing and home repairs or low-cost loans to cover uninsured property losses. Funding also is available to government agencies and certain private nonprofit organizations within the declaration zone.
