## ***Jersey City's 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Artists Studio Tour Continues to Expand Citywide Featuring Hundreds of Artists, Dozens of Exhibitions, Galleries, Museums, & Live Entertainment City & NoGas Pipeline Collaborate to Show Irish Film Opposing Gas Pipeline***

**JERSEY CITY** – Mayor Jerramiah T. Healy, the **Municipal Council**, and the **Jersey City Dept. of Health & Human Services/Division of Cultural Affairs**, in partnership with **Pro Arts**, and the **Hudson Reporter**, present the **2011 Jersey City Artists Studio Tour**, a **FREE** self-guided walking tour featuring galleries, artist studios and ad hoc exhibition sites. The tour will take place on the weekend of **Saturday, October 1st and Sunday, October 2nd from Noon - 6:00 p.m.**

In its 21st year, the Annual *Jersey City Artists Studio Tour* is a weekend celebration of the East Coast's fastest growing art scene that features hundreds of artists, dozens of exhibitions, galleries, museums, live music and performances, food, drink and parties – all located just five minutes from Manhattan.

To kick-off the tour, the new 125,000-square-foot **Mana Contemporary Art Center**, a former industrial complex, located at 888 Newark Avenue on the outskirts of Journal Square, joins the *Jersey City Artists Studio Tour* for the first time as host of the **Studio Tour Kick-Off Celebration** from **6:00p.m. – 10:00p.m.** on **Friday, September 30, 2011.**

The *Jersey City Artists Studio Tour* features a diverse selection of styles and artistic disciplines, from avant-garde video and sculpture to traditional oil painting. Tour goers will have the opportunity to meet and talk to the artists themselves, including interaction with the artists in their working environments. From a diverse art scene, to the eclectic shops and boutiques, indulging in multi-ethnic cuisines at local restaurants along the tour route, or simply enjoying the lively atmosphere strolling from one studio to the next, for visitors and tour goers, *this is a wonderful way to spend the weekend exploring all that Jersey City has to offer.*

Year after year, the Tour continues to expand with added venues and dozens of new artists and attracts thousands of visitors during its two-day run. The *Jersey City Artists Studio Tour* is widely considered New Jersey's premier art and cultural event, and is free and open to the public.

This year, a major new art venue, hundreds of artists and dozens of studios, big group exhibitions, concerts, and the first **Powerhouse Short Film Festival** bring fresh energy and cutting edge art to the 21st Annual Jersey City Artists Studio Tour.

Also open for the 2011 Studio Tour is the **Mana Contemporary Annex**, located at 227 Coles Street, presenting curator Tina Maneca's Exquisite Corpse exhibition – which features collaborative art created by more than 70 Jersey City artists.

Studio Tour visitors can also visit **The Powerhouse Short Film Festival**, which opens Friday September 30 in the Powerhouse Arts District, and features dozens of short independent films showing on the street under tents throughout Studio Tour weekend.

Another new *Jersey City Artists Studio Tour* venue is **Liberty Science Center**, hosting a community exhibition that features Jersey City artists **Bojana Coklyat, Stephanie Riggi, Vanessa Holly** and more.

**Gallery exhibition highlights include:**

- **Mana Contemporary Art Center** features open studios, curated exhibitions by Jim Pustorino (Victory Arts Projects) and **Michelle Mumoli** (Pop Up Art), as well as Mana's major in-house show **“Our Own Directions: 40 Years of Photorealism.”**
- **“Evolutionary Psy Wear”** at **Mary Benson Gallery** (369 Third Street), curated by Uta Brauser of Creative Grove Art Market.
- **“Dividing light, Measuring Darkness”** at **Curious Matter Gallery** (272 Fifth Street). Gallery owners Raymond E. Mingst and Arthur Brusco deliver another meticulously curated and inscrutable exhibition.
- **“Gatherings”** at 58 Gallery presents new work by **painter Kirk Bray**.
- Brennan Courthouse showcases **Sandra Swieder's 911 documentary photography** in **“From Across The River.”**
- **Woolpunk Studios** (298 Newark Avenue), a new downtown artist run space, also opens for its first Studio Tour with a group show **featuring work by Michelle Loughlin and Margaret Murphy**.
- Artist studios open for Studio Tour weekend include **“Garfield Shows”** at 2 Union Street, **The Penthouse** at 326 Montgomery, **Alvin Pettit Studio** at 34 Aster place, and **Gaia Studio** at 315 Third.
- The **8th Annual Fourth Street Art & Music Festival** returns as a major Studio Tour venue with even more artists, open studios, murals, food, bands, and beer.
- Sponsored by Goldman Sachs and hosted by **Parlay Studios**, the **Studio Tour Closing Party** will be displaying the Pro Arts Members' Exhibition, curated by Michael Smith and Meredith Lippman.

In addition to the films, galleries and exhibitions listed above, the City of Jersey City, in conjunction with non-profit NoGas Pipeline, will be showing *The Pipe* – an award-winning documentary by filmmaker Richard O'Donnell about the small Irish town of Rosspport and what happened when Shell Oil decided they were going to run a gas pipeline out of the ocean floor and across their village.

The film, with a running time of 83 minutes, will be shown on Saturday, Oct. 1st and Sunday, Oct. 2nd at 11 a.m., 2 p.m., and 4 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers, 280 Grove Street.



The Jersey City Artists Studio Tour was here.



The very first tour took place on October 6, 1990 and featured more than 70 artists' studios, 18 exhibitions, dozens of volunteers, and about 1500 people attending.



Every year, the tour has grown into a significant part of Jersey City's cultural calendar attracting thousands of visitors and now has expanded throughout the City.

## FROM NEW YORK CITY...


By Car: Lincoln Tunnel to Hoboken Exit straight ahead. Turn left on 14th Street and proceed to Washington Street. Turn right and continue to Observer Highway. Turn right and proceed to Grove Street/Manila Avenue. Turn left and continue 1 mile to Grove Street Station.

By PATH: Take Journal Square or Newark train to Grove Street Station (trains run every 15 min. on weekends). Shuttle van stops on C. Columbus Dr. by Grove Street across from the station. Information table is located outside the station.

## FROM NEW JERSEY...


By Car: Take NJ Turnpike to Exit 14C (Grand Street). Proceed along Grand Street to Grove Street and turn left. Grove Street Station straight ahead on Christopher Columbus Drive.

By LightRail: Take the NJ Transit LightRail to Marin Blvd. Stop. Walk north along Marin Blvd. to C. Columbus Drive. Shuttle van stop at the corner. (Lightrail also stops at Liberty State Park, Jersey Avenue and Harsimus Cove in the vicinity of many sites along the Tour route.)


